

City of Lodi Municipal Vehicle Registration Fee

Q: Why am I being charged a municipal vehicle registration fee?

A: With declining state aid for transportation, the City established an annual fee as a way to generate funds for transportation and street repairs.

Municipal Vehicle Registration Fee Facts

1. The fee is a flat \$20.00.
2. Anyone who owns an automobile or truck weighing under 8,000 lbs. will pay the fee.
3. Some motor vehicles are exempt.
4. Verify the correct county and city, village, or township where your vehicle is customarily kept.
5. If vehicle location needs to be corrected, either indicate the correct information on the notice and submit the appropriate fee by mail, e-mail WisDOT at vehiclequestions@dot.wi.gov or call (608) 266-1466.



How will the fee be collected?

1. The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) will begin collecting the fee May 1, 2016.
2. When plates are issued, the fee must be included with the regular registration fee for the vehicle when first applying for registration.
3. When plates are renewed, WisDOT sends a renewal notice at least 30 days prior to plate registration expiration. The renewal notice shows the total fee due including the municipal vehicle registration fee.
